POOL RULES

Please think about the following pool rules when planning your swim party!

Swimming for birthday parties is during Open Swim time, so there could be other members in the pool at the time of your party. Swimmers include: any children, people in your group who are members and any parents who want to/have to swim with their children.

1. Swim suits ONLY. No cut-offs, t-shirts, gym shorts or cover-ups permitted in the pools.
2. Longer hair must be tied back.
3. You must shower before entering pools.
4. Children 6 years or younger must be accompanied **IN the water** by an adult at least 18 years old.
5. If a child needs a life jacket to swim (regardless of age), a parent must be **IN the water** with the child **within arm's reach** of the child. Children in flotation devices may only use the shallow end of the pool and are not permitted in the deep end, even with a parent.
6. Children needing individualized flotation devices will be permitted to use the life jackets provided by the YMCA or their own Coast Guard approved life jacket. No other flotation devices will be permitted in the pool such as noodles, water wings or other inflatables.
7. All children 12 and under are required to take a swim test in order to use the deep end of the pool. All swimmers 12 and under must wear appropriate swim band before entering the pool.
8. Children wearing red bans must be accompanied by an adult **IN the water** and are limited to the shallow end of Pool 1 or all of Pool 2. Parents are not permitted to take red band swimmers into the deep end.
9. Goggles only covering eyes may be worn; snorkel masks that cover one's nose will not be permitted in the pool
10. No food or drink in the pool areas, only water and absolutely **NO** glass containers.
11. Diving blocks are for YMCA program and competition use only while supervised by YMCA staff or coaches.

HAVE YOUR BIRTHDAY PARTY AT THE Y!

- The YMCA offers a variety of birthday party packages on the weekends for YMCA Members AND Non-Members. *Non-Members must provide photo ID and complete a non-member form. Megan's Law check will also be completed prior to party date.
- All rentals require a \$100 security deposit due in advance of your party. This will be returned the week following your party, provided there are no damages to the room or YMCA equipment. The rental fee is due in advance of the party and will be submitted for payment one week prior to your rental.
- The host may arrive 30 minutes prior to the party to set up. Tables & chairs may be re-arranged to suit your needs. Table sizes are 6' x 2.6'. There is a small room in Phillips' Hall that has a refrigerator/freezer available for use.
- Groups are responsible for providing their own party decorations and food. Please do not affix anything to the wallpapered walls.
- The host is responsible for the behavior of all party guests; all facility rules and policies apply.
- The YMCA is not responsible for any personal injuries which occur during a party, or for lost or stolen items. The YMCA assumes no responsibility for personal belongings or valuables.
- Theme parties are planned for the package you choose. Please plan for the appropriate number of children based on the package you choose. Extra kids will not be planned for. Children under the age of 3 must have parent supervision to help them with the activities. Kids will enjoy the first hour of their party doing crafts and activities with YMCA staff based on the party theme chosen. For Splash parties, activities will take place in the pool. The rest of the time can be spent in Phillips' Hall-A for food and gifts.

YOUTH AQUATIC SAFETY PROGRAM! TEST.MARK.PROTECT.

Aquatic safety at our pools is our first priority. If you choose Pool 1, all children ages 12 years and younger must participate in a swimming skills assessment & will be provided a colored wristband based on their swimming ability. Non-swimmers will be required to wear a US Coast Guard Approved Lifejacket and will be restricted to shallow water. Lifejackets are available. Children who have already been tested may pick up their band at the Membership Desk. If you choose Pool 2, all children, regardless of age, will be considered non-swimmers and will receive a red band. The party must plan to have **1 adult** actively engaged **IN the water for every 3 children ages 12 and younger who have a red band. Your party facilitator will count as one of your adults.**
